Community Hope and Resources for Psychosis (CHRp) Program

Initial Assessment informs:

Four Stepped Levels of Care (LOC) that include:

- a. Access to public education,
- b. Maintaining current community providers with free consultation over time,
- c. Adding some components of specialty care, or
- d. Transferring to short-term Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC)

And Re-Assessments every 6 months up to 2 yrs
